What can I study?

Study Abroad students are able to enrol in undergraduate or postgraduate courses depending on the previous level of completed study. The Rockhampton campus has two major terms (semesters) available for Study Abroad.

- If you are currently studying at undergraduate/ bachelor level in your home country, you should look at undergraduate programs and courses at CQUniversity.
- If you are currently enrolled at graduate level such as in a Masters program, then you should consider courses available at postgraduate level at CQUniversity – these may include courses from Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma and Masters level programs.

You have the choice of creating your own program by choosing subjects/courses from across different discipline areas; you can create your own specialisation by choosing courses from one discipline area; or you can choose from one of our 'program packages' which focus on specific areas of interest.

 - 2 On the left hand navigation menu, click on 'courses'
 - 3 On the left hand navigation menu, click on 'advanced course search'
 - 4 From the search menu choose 'Rockhampton Campus' (or preferred campus) from the drop down box
 - 5 Choose Term one (Feb start) or Term two (July start) from the drop down box
 - 6 Click search
- **Remember to choose your preferred campus** when you search for courses. The main campus for Study Abroad is Rockhampton (ROK), where special Study Abroad packages are available.
 - o There are other campus options for Study Abroad including Mackay, Bundaberg, Gladstone, Brisbane and Sydney. Please enquire for further information as subject/course availability is limited at these campuses.
 - o Study Abroad is not available at the Melbourne Campus.

- **Choose your preferred term**

- o Term one is late February - end of June.
- o Term two is Early July - mid October.
- o Term three is November - end of January
- Term three in Rockhampton for Education majors only and is not a mainstream term for Australian students. Please enquire further information.
- Term three study is available at our city campuses for fee-paying students only on a fee per course basis.

- **Find courses**

- o Undergraduate courses start with a number 1xxxx. Graduate courses start with a number 2xxxx.

- **Plan your term**

- o A regular full time load for undergraduate study is four courses per term.
- o A regular full time load for graduate study is three courses per term.
- o Please select double the number of courses you require per term in case some of your selections are unavailable – eg At undergraduate level, choose eight courses.

Credit system and grading

Students must seek prior approval for their course selections from their home university, **before commencing their Study Abroad term at CQUniversity** to be able to receive academic credit for their chosen courses. CQUniversity will provide an academic transcript to all Study Abroad students on completion of their Study Abroad term. In Australia grades are issued on a seven point scale.

HD (High Distinction) = 7 (85 - 100%)

D (Distinction) = 6 (75 - 84%)

C (Credit) = 5 (65 - 74%)

P (Pass) = 4 (50 - 64%)

PC (Pass Conceded) = 3 (40 - 49%)

Undergraduate Study

A standard full time credit load at CQUniversity is 24 credit points consisting of four courses of six credit points each. The minimum enrolment is three courses and the maximum is five.

6 units of credit = 3-4 credits in the US system

6 units of credit = 7.5 ECTS in the European system

Graduate Study

A standard full time credit load at CQUniversity is 24 credit points consisting of 3 courses of 8 credit points each.

8 units of credit = 1 standard course/unit = 3-4 graduate credits in the US system.

8 units of credit = 10 ECTS in the European system

Entry Requirements

Entry Requirements

Undergraduate Study

- Students must have successfully completed at least twelve months of full-time university study in their home country at the time of application.
- Students from the USA must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4-point scale.
- Other students please enquire at your international office regarding academic entry requirements.
- Students who do not have English as a first language or have not completed secondary or tertiary study via the medium of English, must also meet our English entry requirements, ie have an equivalent of an overall IELTS band score of 6 (with no individual band score of less than 5.5) OR a TOEFL score of 550, including a TWE score of 4 (computer based score of 213). More info on English Language requirements can be found on the website:

- Students wishing to enrol in Engineering courses require an overall IELTS band score of 6.5 (with no individual band score of less than 6.0) or equivalent TOEFL.

Graduate Study

- Students must have successfully completed an approved undergraduate university degree in their home country at the time of application.
- Students from the USA must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4-point scale.
- Other students please enquire at your international office regarding academic entry requirements.
- Students who do not have English as a first language or have not completed secondary or tertiary study via the medium of English, must also meet our English entry requirements, ie have an equivalent of an overall IELTS band score of 6 (with no individual band score of less than 5.5) OR a TOEFL score of 550, including a TWE score of 4 (computer based score of 213). More info on English Language requirements can be found on the website:
www.cquni.edu.au. Students wishing to enrol in Engineering courses require an overall IELTS band score of 6.5 (with no individual band score of less than 6.0) or equivalent TOEFL.

Accommodation options

A range of accommodation options are available in our locations. At CQUniversity Rockhampton, students can choose from:

- Capricornia College – CQUniversity’s on-campus accommodation option offers accommodation and meals on a full-term basis. Each of the single bedroom/study rooms is furnished and equipped with telephone and internet connections. Cost is approximately AU\$4840 per term (approximately 15 weeks) – inclusive of meals. (For more information, please visit the website: www.college.cqu.edu.au)
- Homestay – Homestay accommodation with a local host family can be arranged through our English Language Centre which administers a Homestay accommodation database. Homestay arrangements can be made in advance of arrival and only on payment of a non-refundable placement fee of AU\$180. Homestay accommodation is approximately AU\$750 per month, including meals.



Accommodation options

- House or apartment rental (available on individual or share basis). Rockhampton campus provides a free accommodation placement service. Our international student services officer will find suitable accommodation close to campus before you arrive in Australia. On our other campuses you will be referred to external accommodation providers.

Assistance will include: advice about rental bonds and contractual arrangements, provision of information about rental accommodation currently available, and introduction to other students seeking to share accommodation. Cost will vary according to the facilities provided. The range for rental will be from AU\$480 – AU\$700 per month per person. This does not include food, electricity, gas or phone.



Student support services

Studying overseas can bring unexpected challenges along with excitement. Student Services at CQUniversity provides assistance from arrival in Australia to departure. Our services and assistance include:

- Free airport reception on arrival at Rockhampton
- Assistance with accommodation
- Advice about health insurance and health care
- Transport information
- Enrolment advice
- Study skills support
- Part-time employment information

Climate and Clothing

In Queensland the seasons are not as clearly defined as in some other regions of Australia and in other countries. During September to May the daytime temperatures can range from 24 – 36C, while from June to August daytime temperatures can range from 18 – 24C. The warmer temperatures offer an opportunity to dress casually in cool light clothing. T-shirts and shorts are a popular choice among our students. It is recommended that you wear a hat and long sleeves for protection from sunburn during the summer months. Our winter temperatures are usually very mild. Light jackets or sweatshirts and jeans are usually sufficient.

Overseas Student Health Cover

International students must obtain health insurance – Overseas Student Health Cover Scheme (OSHC). Medibank Private is the preferred OSHC provider for CQUniversity.

Payment of the total health cover premium must be made when you pay your tuition fee, prior to coming to Australia.

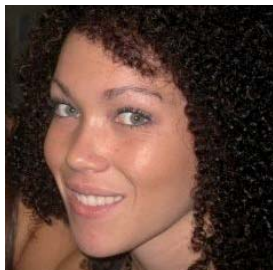
CQUniversity has a sporting complex which offers a range of weight machines for muscle conditioning and a selection of cardiovascular equipment – treadmills, steppers, rowers and ergonomic cycles for fitness conditioning. A 400 metre grassed athletics oval is also available to members for walking or running. For those who prefer the water, there is a 25 metre, eight lane pool on the Rockhampton campus.

How do I apply to CQUniversity?

STEP 1

Complete the Study Abroad Application Form. The Application Form is available to download from the website www.studyabroad.cqu.edu.au

If you need assistance completing the form you can contact your home university international office, the CQUniversity campus where you wish to study, or a CQUniversity partner agency in your home country.

STEP 2

Attach relevant documents.

- **We require a certified copy of your academic transcript of your current institution.**
- **We also require evidence of your English Language proficiency if English is not your first language. Please visit our website www.cquni.edu.au for acceptable proof of English language proficiency.**

All certified documents that are in languages other than English must be accompanied by certified translated (English) copies where an approved translator has conducted the translation. The certification stamp must include the certifier's printed name, title or position, signature and date of notary. The certification must be obtained from a Justice of the Peace, Commissioner of Declarations, a selected registered agent of CQUniversity or the issuing authority or institution. Documents issued outside of Australia must be certified by an equivalent to a Notarial Public. Please do not send original documents with your application.

STEP 3

Check your completed application. Do a final check. Make sure you have included your preference of eight courses for undergraduate level studies or six courses for postgraduate level studies.

STEP 4

Submit your application. You can complete your application online, or you can send your application by email or post, or submit it through a CQUniversity registered agent. Please allow up to three weeks for your application to be processed.

Note – Government Loans

CQUniversity welcomes students using government loans to finance their education. CQUniversity is an approved foreign school for USA students. Students should quote the following reference number in their loan application documents – OPE identification number 03097500.

What happens next?

Successful applicants will receive an Offer of Admission which includes all the information you will require to proceed with entry to CQUniversity. A Conditional Offer of Admission is made to those applicants who are required to send additional information. If you do not meet the requirements for entry to CQUniversity, please contact us to discuss possible options.

Accept your Offer of Admission. To accept your offer of a place you need to: return your signed International Student Contract to the campus listed on your Offer of Admission; you must pay the term tuition fee along with the Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). Instructions for payment are provided in the Offer of Admission pack.

Apply for your student visa. CQUniversity will issue an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE) once you have paid your tuition fee and OSCHC. To assist us in issuing your eCOE please ensure that you include the following information with your Remittance Advice form: your passport number (please provide in the space provided on your International Student Contract; the location of the visa office where your eCOE should be issued to; and where (and how) you would like the eCOE sent. Once the eCOE has been issued by CQUniversity, you can apply for your student visa.

Before you arrive

Once you have received your student visa, you will need to make your travel arrangements. It is important that you notify the CQUniversity campus of your arrival details at least once week prior to arrival. You need to plan to arrive at the campus at least one week prior to commencement of study so that you attend and participate in orientation sessions and finalise accommodation arrangements. Each campus has orientation sessions which will assist you to adjust to life and study in Australia.
