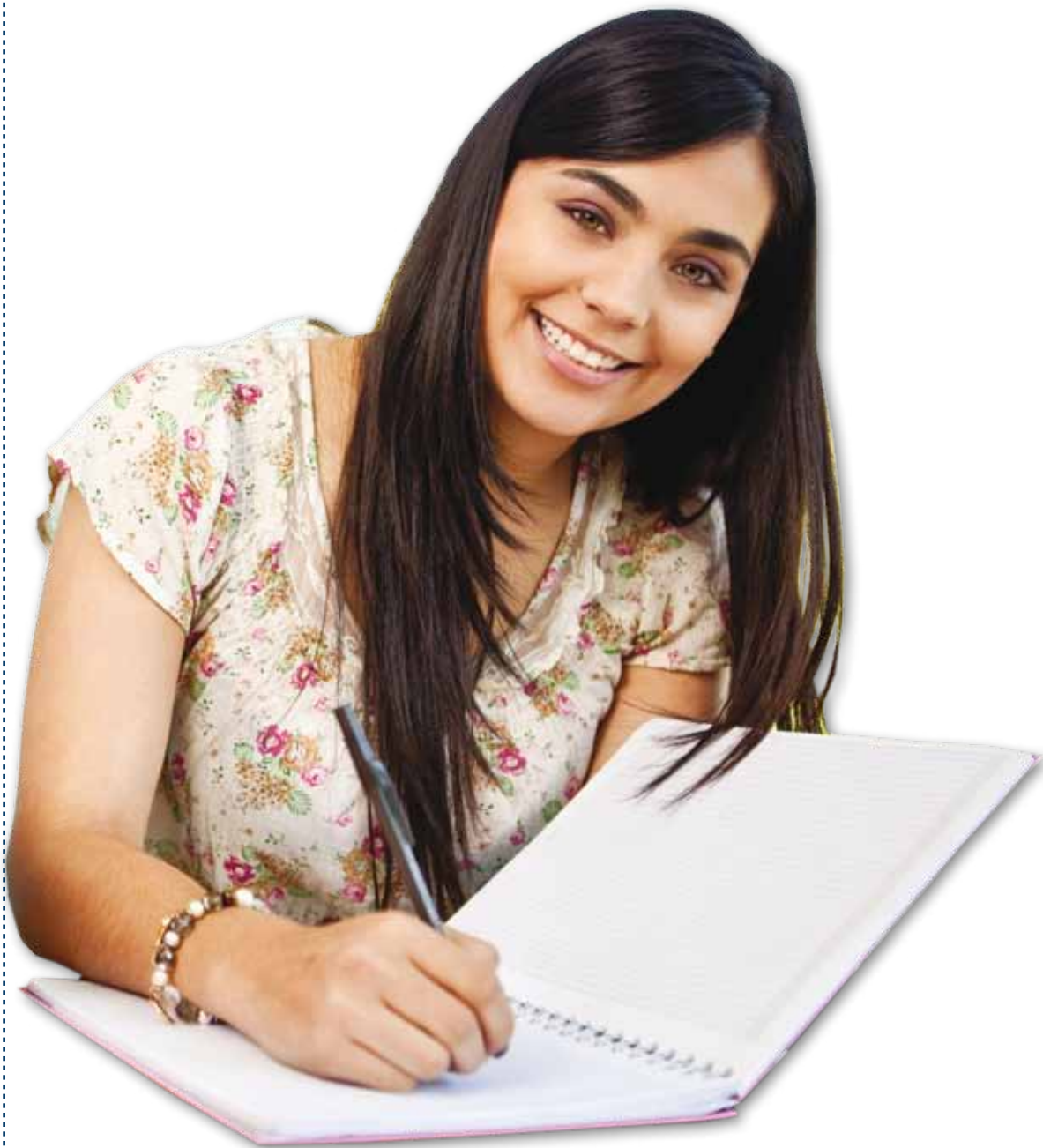

Except where otherwise indicated examples of "Fees per Course" in the schedule assume that fees are calculated for a standard Undergraduate course of 6 units of credit or a standard Postgraduate course of 8 units of credit. However individual courses may have a unit of credit value different to the standard value – please check the Student Handbook for information on units of credit per course. The total cost of study will depend on the courses selected, as not all courses will cost the same amount.

Text books are an additional cost and are course specific. PT = part-time study.

Not all external programs are offered full time. Not all specialisations or majors are available at all campuses. It is your responsibility to make yourself aware of the requirements and pre-requisites of the program of study that you wish to undertake. Therefore you should consult with a CQUniversity program advisor and the CQUniversity Handbook (at <http://handbook.cqu.edu.au>) to receive the latest information on your intended program of study.

All calculations for Postgraduate programs are based on selecting electives from the same faculty as the main program. Fees for research based programs will depend on the discipline area chosen. High cost research discipline areas are published in the Tuition Fee Schedule on the above website.

International students on a student visa must study full-time on-campus. Due to Australian visa regulations, international students can only study Distance Education programs while residing outside of Australia. International students in Australia on an appropriate visa may study part-time if allowed under their visa conditions.
