ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Specialist academic student support is provided by the Learning Skills Unit (LSU) to all students. This is a free service that provides you with ongoing academic support and assists you in the development of your academic potential.

CAREER DEVELOPMENT

The Training, Employment and Career Coaching (TECC) unit assists students to graduate with not only a degree, but also with skills and experience that are relevant to the workplace. TECC assists you with finding a job, whether that be part-time or casual work while studying, volunteer work, work experience in your area of study, or full-time work once you have completed your studies. You can also attend workshops on developing your presentation skills for job interviews.

Action required by student

STEP 1

Direct application; no need to apply through QTAC. Check that all supporting certified* documents are attached by using the checklist on the application form

STEP 4

Ensure all conditions (if any) have been satisfied

STEP 5

To accept your offer and apply for your electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE), you will need to return:

- International Student Contract with your signature and passport number
- Make your first payment** via electronic remittance, credit card or bank deposit

STEP 8

Apply for your student visa
