

# Accessing a Wireless Network using an iPhone

CQUniversity students and staff have a number of options available if they wish to connect to the internet and access their online resources using their personal iPhones.

Outlined below are some instructions on how to connect to **CQUniversity Roam** (when studying on campus) and **EduRoam** (if you are a visitor from another University) using an iPhone.

## Connecting to CQUniversity Roam

1. Click the **"Settings"** icon located on the main screen of the iPhone.
2. Select the **"Wi-Fi"** option. This prompts the phone to find available wireless networks.
- 3.a. Select **"CQUroam"** from the list of networks (offered on campus).
- 4.a. Enter your CQUniversity username and password and click **"Join"**
5. Students and staff should now be connected to the internet via their iPhone.

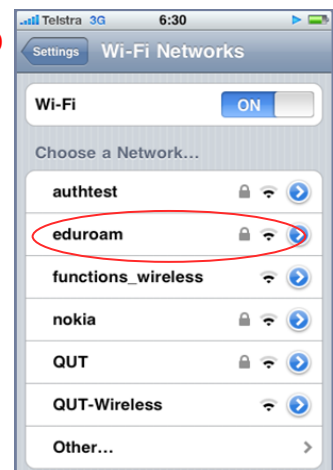
## Connecting to EduRoam



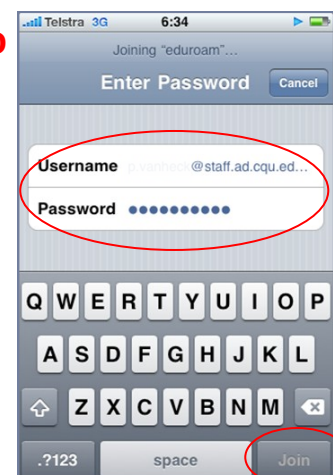
Complete steps 1. & 2. as outlined above.

- 3.b. Select **"eduroam"** from the list of networks (available at a most Australian Universities).
- 4.b. Enter your username and password for your institution and click **"Join"**  
*Username: your institution username@someuni.edu.au*  
*Password: your institution password*
5. Students and staff should now be connected to EduRoam via their iPhone

## Wi-Fi Hot Spots

Wi-Fi Hotspots are wireless internet access points that are widely available around most city areas. They can be accessed from many places including Coffee Shops, McDonalds, Motels, Internet Cafes, Airports and Libraries.

Some are free to use and other charge a fee. To find out more information about a particular Wi-Fi Hotspot it is best to ask the establishment where you require the connection. Some Hotspots may not require you to pay in person. You can switch on your wireless and if a connection is available, just open a web browser and it will automatically redirect you to the Hotspot's payment page.
